

Cross Borneo Trek West to East

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" You must have a good level of fitness and adventurous spirit and a strong sense of determination, as conditions and accommodations are challenging. You will use buses, public house boat, chartered motorized canoes to access the jungle for a rugged days of trekking.

You will have sleep in the simple houses of the villager with basic facilities and on the house boats. The trekking is tough and often wet, the only way to appreciate the primeval jungle of Kalimantan and the most traditional Dayak Tribes settlements as well as the wildlife"



**16 Days /15 Nights
(Tour Code: IJ 007)**

Day 01: Arrival Jakarta

Upon arrival in Soekarno Hatta - Jakarta Internatinal airport, we will transfer you to hotel at down town. Free program, all meals on your personal leisure.

Day 02: Jakarta - Pontianak - Putussibau

Today, we will transfer you to Jakarta airport to catch a domestic flight to Pontianak (West Borneo). Upon arrival at Supadio airport of Pontianak, you will have connecting flight to Putussibau by KALSTAR or TRIGANA AIR. Sightseeing the town as you can visit the traditional market here (B).

Day 03: Putussibau - Kapuas River

After have a breakfast at hotel in Putussibau towards to the headwaters of the Kapuas by long boat. Needed all necessary supplies estimate day, as far upstream as possible and passing several river side settlements. Safe bet is overnight on the riverside and encampment or local house floor (B,L,D).

Day 04: Kapuas - Bungan River - Tanjung Lokang

En route, rapids will excite and delay matters no point here going into the drills, needed in white , water such as this suffice to say boats, will be manhandled, powered, punted, and pulled upstream. Sometimes portaging contents to appoint above a particularly tire some cascade.

Here in 1826, en route of from the Mahakam headwater, the first European to reach Kalimantan interior George Muller of the Dutch colonial service, came to stick end, attacked by Iban's Dayak.

Eventually, above a final tributary, when the water content is halved yet again, there is nothing for it, but to dispense with boat and boat man service and to proceed on foot. At the little settlement of Long Bungan, Easil confuse with Long Bungan, on the other side of divide, or some way belong of the place called Tanjung Lokang, probably as far upstream as we can get by longboats. Meals to be prepared and overnight at local house (B,L,D).



Day 05: Tanjung Lokang - Sungai (River) Bulet

Across up Land Ladang "slash and burn , long fellow dry " rice field through the forest by way often ill- defined trails. Typical 05 to 06 hours walking/day plus breaks is envisaged. It's enough. Safe bet is overnight on the river side to construct our bivouac type shelters of wood and water proof awning. Meals to be provide and overnight at local house (B,L,D).

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Day 06: Sungai Bulet - Sungai Bungan

Act as alternative footpaths ones, which sometimes result in wading - waist and chest high. Higher up the stream of Bungan river is must of boulders, pools and whirlpools and buttresses of steel gray out crops. A clearing by river or stream is routine place to construct our bivouac type shelters of wood or water proof awning (B,L,D).

Day 07: Sungai Bungan -Sungai Bangun Lea

Trekking here is never boring, there is always new development, estimating distance, location, progress the road to follow, the meals to be prepared, the night site to decide on (B,L,D).

Day 08: Sungai Bangun Lea - Piang Lo'Ong

The central divide the watershed between the Kapuas and Mahakam is in fact a fairly low altitude,saddle in Muller Range of the Kalimantan Highland. The maximum altitude of the crossing is estimated less then 1500 meters.

Occasionally, one can expect splendid be "Belawang" totem, draped in offering. The edge of waters courses in the often steep, hanging like rope that whisk - trapeze artist to high wire performance. Information is both limited and so what contradictory, but the route on the upward Kapuas side of the divide is believed to be steep in many sections but easier on the descent Mahakam side. Meals to be prepared and overnight in bivouac type shelters of wood and water proof awning (B,L,D).

Day 09: Piang Lo'Ong - Muller Range

The journey will be continued through the tropical rain forest, a dip in the river, a rest to be taken and surrounding to be examined an investigation of just a few square meters quill reveal something different of animal every time. Meals to be prepared and overnight on dome tent (B,L,D).

Day 10: Muller Range - Muara Cutting

Typically, 07 hours walking today and the guide might introduce you to the skills of Dayak Fishing and firelighting sodden wood. In your trip will be accompanied by porters from Dayak people. Meals to be prepared and overnight in bivouac type shelters of wood and water proof awning (B,L,D).

Day 11: Muara Cutting - Saite - Mahakam River

Early morning hunting the animals in the jungle by Dayak hunters then return for breakfast, typically 5 hours walking to reach Site. Overnight at camp (B,L,D).

Day 12: Muara Sai'te - Mahakam River

Another 3 hours of walk to reach Mahakam river side, upon arrival the river side, pick up by the long boat (locally called Cas) then take us to Tiong Ohang village. Overnight at local house (B,L,D).

Day 13: Tiong Ohang - Long Bangun

Breakfast at the long house, (not in the long boat) then another 8 - 10 hours sail by boat to Long Bangun. Overnight at local long house (B,L,D).

Day 14: Long Bangun - House Boat on Mahakam River

After breakfast, leave the village of Long Bangun by house boat. Lunch and dinner provided in the house boat. During the sailing trip, you can explore and learn the local way of live ' river side civilization' which is much different from what we normally have in the dry land area (B,L,D).

Day 15: House Boat on Mahakam River - Samarinda

Arrival at the house boat harbor in the afternoon. Check in to hotel middle class in Samarinda. The rest of the day is free for your own activities (B,L).

Day 16: Samarinda - Balikpapan

Breakfast at hotel then in the appropriate time, drive to Balikpapan for your next destination (B).

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Trekking to habitats of Sumatran Elephants

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Try to get a great experience to visit and explore the habitats of Sumatran Elephants, you may do feel and see the real conflict happen between the human and wild Sumatran Elephants on the farm village.



One reason that you should to join this wildlife trek because you may participate to save the elephants. Other experience is boat trip to Sebesi and Sebuk Island which has a beautiful coral lives here and flash back the history of wreck ship shank on the clean blue water of Sunda Strait during the World War II.

**4 Days / 3 Nights
(Tour Code: IJ 008)**

Day 01: Jakarta - Bandar Lampung airport - Way Kambas National Park (Satwa Lodge)

Upon your arrival in Bandar Lampung airport, you will be picked up by our guide staff and we will directly drive you to Way Kambas National Park. After you have dinner at Satwa Lodge, the lodge bird guide will escort you with a torch light. You will walk into the fields and to the forest edge. You will see owls, night jays, and frogs. Some nights mammals such as mongoose, civet, deer and pigs can be seen. Return to Satwa Lodge for stay overnight (D).

Day 02: Explore the habitats of wild Sumatran Elephants - Kalianda Resort

On today, after you have a breakfast (at 06.00 am) then you will be escorted by two Rangers on a walk and boat trip. Start walk from the Way Kanan as ranger base in the National Park to the wetlands (habitat of the endemic white winged wood duck). You will be walking through the clear waters of the swamp and wild animals territory and might see wild Elephant or Tapir at dusk on the wetlands. Keen wildlife and bird watchers can camp with the rangers at the Rawa Gajah swamp to look for birds at dawn. It will take 8 hours duration.

Return to Satwa Lodge for have lunch, afterward you will do one hour Elephant riding experience on a nature appreciation track, observing birds and butterflies. As you will see their Elephant brought in from the tether field, bathed and saddled. On return you will feed two coconuts to their Elephant and purchase more food from the stalls if you wish.

Elephant rides are strongly encouraged by the lodge due to the dual benefit to the Elephant of exercise and opportunity to browse in the forest. Comfortable Elephant-friendly saddles are provided by the lodge. They are encouraged to ask their mahout about their Elephant and to interact kindly with it. Your participation will contribute to the welfare of the Elephants. At the evening transfer to Kalianda Resort for check in service. Dinner will be on your personal expenses at the hotel restaurant (B,L).

Day 03: Kalianda Resort - Sebesi & Sebuk Island - Kalianda Resort

Today is full day tour to visit Sebesi and Sebuk Island for snorkeling activities. You may have seen disintegrated part of Eversten Vessel which sank on 1942 during the World War II. At the afternoon, return to Kalianda resort for stay overnight. Dinner will be on your personal expenses at the Hotel restaurant (B,Lunch Box).

Day 04: Kalianda Resort - Jakarta

On today after have a breakfast at Resort, you will have transferred to Jakarta by land drive across the Sunda Strait by FERRY. If the weather is clearly, you may see Krakatau in far distance. It will be great experiences to have sightseeing the south side of Sumatra Island by land and sea journey. The land drive will have 7 hours drive from Kalianda resort to Jakarta (B) END OF JOURNEY.

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Orangutan Tour - Central Borneo

Visit the habitat of orangutan at both camp "Pondok Tanggui and Camp Leakey in Borneo forest" at morning and afternoon feeding time. Waiting for the orangutan coming while the ranger calling their name "Yoooo Kosasi Yoooo".

Female orangutan and her juvenile also her infant on her shoulder crashing the trees, moving slowly from the tree to tree reach free banana which are placed on feeding platform. You will soon find yourself surrounded by this great red apes.

**3 Days / 2 Nights
(Tour Code: IJ 009)**

Day 01: Semarang - Pangkalan Bun - Kumai - Park

Upon arrival at Pangkalan Bun Airport you will be picked up by our local staff and take you to Kumai to board on the boat.

The boat is a traditional Klotok wooden river boat about 12m by 2m with a roof which forms the upper deck where you can view the rain forest as it glides by.

On the way up stop at Tanjung Harapan Rehabilitation center for ex captive orangutan. Witness feeding time at 15.00. The guide team includes the boatman, a cook and expert guide. In the peaceful afternoon we will slowly explore the quite river by the klotok while observe the monkeys along the riverside.

Dinner and overnight on the boat, simple mattress, pillow, fine meals, bottled "mineral" water, mosquito net, kitchen, simple toilet available on boat besides the familiar - helpful guides and boatmen or spend the night at lodge near by the river (L,D).

Day 02: Park - Pondok Tanggui - Camp Leakey - Boat/lodge

After breakfast board the klotok to travel up river for about 2½ hours boating and then up a side creek to Camp Leakey where the older orangutans are reintroduced into the rain forest and also known as research center for Orangutan.

On the up stop at Pondok Tanggui to see morning feeding time for ex-captive orangutan. Lunch then take short hike at the forest until the time to witness feeding time at 14.00 pm for old rehabilitation orangutan given additional foods. Overnight on the boat or at Rimba Lodge (B,L,D).



Day 03: Boat/Lodge - Kumai - Pangkalan Bun Airport

Free morning program until time transfer to Pangkalan Bun airport for catch your return flight to your next destination (B). END OF JOURNEY

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Ujung Kulon Trekking
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Explore the habitat of Javanicus Rhino at Ujung Kulon national park as known as the rarely park on the western corner of Java island. You will find the unforgettable experience due to canoing at Cigenter river as like as Amazon river canoing experience. You may combine this wildlife trekking with in climb Cracatoa by 1,5 hours sailboat start from Carita beach. If you are the birdwatching lovers so this is their forest home.

**4 Days / 3 Nights
(Tour Code: IJ 010)**

Day 01: Jakarta - Sumur village - Taman Jaya village

Your adventure trip start by driving to Taman Jaya village as the entrance gate of Ujung Kulon national park. En route stop at Sumur village for change vehicle by local transportation because the unpaved road and truly four wheel drive. Stay at local house to explore the fisherman village. You will have an interactive communication with the villagers to get more experiences due to their daily life (B,L,D).

Day 02: Taman Jaya village - Karangranjang campsite

Start explore the habitat of Javanicus Rhino by walking through Karangranjang campsite. It takes 6 - 8 hours walk in the deep of mangrove forest. Stay camp at ranger station complex and enjoy the beautiful view of South Indian ocean (B,L,D).



Day 03: Karangranjang campsite - Kalajetan - Taman Jaya village - Handeleum island

Today is another adventure experience to explore the park by walking back through Taman Jaya with different route. Catch the fisherman boat to sail to Handeleum island as the habitat of deers and some gray monkey. Stay at ranger station (B,L,D).

Day 04: Handeleum island - Cigenter river - Taman Jaya village - Jakarta

Early morning is fascinating view to be seen at Cigenter river by canoing. Stop at wildlife observation station and afterward you will back directly to Taman Jaya village for return drive back to Jakarta.

If the weather is clearly, you can see Cracatoa on far away distance. You will arrive at the late evening into your hotel at Jakarta (B,L,D). END OF JOURNEY



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
